	Uniform pants and shirts and alterations
	Shoes or boots
	Gloves – winter, driving, searching
	Winter coat or jacket
	Haircuts
	Shaving – razors, cream, electric razors
	Sunglasses or range glasses
	Safety vest / bullet proof vest
	Dry Cleaning / washing
	Other uniform items

	Guns (any guns)
	Ammo and reload gear
	Targets and range fees
	Duty belt and accessories
	Flashlight and holder
	Badge and badge case

	Gun sages – home and vehicle
