Tax Tips online, visit the News section of IRS.gov or type "Tax Tips" into the search box.

Taxpayers can receive IRS Tax Tips automatically each day via email by signing up for a free service on IRS.gov. From the Subscriptions link on the top right of the IRS website, choose "IRS Tax Tips" on the drop-down menu, and then click on "Subscribe." Click on "more" to subscribe to the IRS Tax Tips in Spanish.

The IRS also has a number of other <u>e-subscriptions</u> to which taxpayers, tax professionals and others may subscribe to receive tax information via email from the IRS during the tax-filing season and the rest of the year. As of last Friday, more than one third of the taxpayers who will file by the deadline had yet to do so; the average refund for those received one as of the March 20 was \$2,893.
